



EWANRIGG JUNIOR SCHOOL REMOTE LEARNING

QUICK GUIDE FOR PARENTS- ALL THAT YOU NEED TO KNOW!

- This is an outline of what a day of remote learning will look like for pupil of Ewanrigg Junior School.
- The government has instructed primary school children to complete a minimum of 4 hours work per day.
- At Ewanrigg Junior School you will find a range of lessons. Some of these are recorded lessons by the teachers, some are recorded lessons from government funded sites e.g. Oak Academy and BBC TV programmes, and others are links to personalised online learning tasks.
- All learning activities are set through the online platform of Seesaw. Children and parents/carers should check this every morning to see the learning that is expected for the day ahead.

Please see below what is expected from a pupil at Ewanrigg Junior School.

ENGLISH

- Daily session of personalised learning on IDL English www.idlsgroup.com
- Pre-recorded lesson and tasks linked to the teaching video. Check your child's Seesaw for these.
- Daily reading: All children have access to EPIC reading in order to provide a range of online reading books at home. This should be recorded and sent to the class teacher on Seesaw.

SPELLING

All children have access to Reading Eggs or Reading Eggspress. Personalised spelling activities will be set on this weekly. <https://readingeggspress.co.uk/> or <https://readingeggs.co.uk/> The teacher will give your child instructions on their Seesaw account

MATHS

- Daily session of personalised learning on IDL Maths www.idlsgroup.com
- Pre-recorded lesson and tasks linked to the teaching video. These may be using videos from White Rose Maths. All links will be in your child's Seesaw for these.

Daily session of TT Rockstars <https://trockstars.com/>

For Maths and English, all children have access to Classroom Secrets for children where personalised courses in Maths and English can be set. Your child will get this information from their Seesaw account.

OTHER SUBJECTS

- Our 2 year learning cycle will continue throughout a period of remote learning. Children will be given a range of learning tasks across a wide range of subjects. These tasks will be set on their Seesaw account.

- Daily physical exercise tasks will be set for all children.

HOW CAN YOU ACCESS UPDATES?

- FACEBOOK LIVE - Every Thursday at 2pm, Miss Craig will have an online assembly. This will include celebrations and shout outs for the week but also includes any updates. The assembly is recorded making it accessible at a time suitable to you.

HOW YOU CAN HELP YOUR CHILD?

We are relying on your help!

- Encourage your child to get up and dressed ready for the day.
- Check your child's Seesaw with them every morning to see what they have to do.
- Ensure your child completes any work set and uploads it correctly
- Ensure your child has regular breaks.
- Help your child to send work back to their teacher
- Listen to your child read regularly - a minimum of four times a week
- Contact your child's class teacher on Seesaw if there are any problems.
