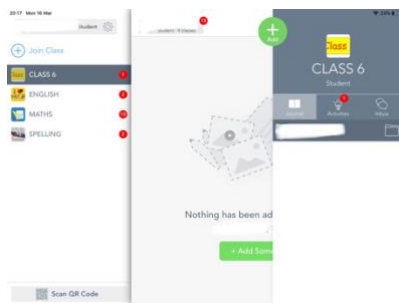
Seesaw is an online platform, therefore access to the internet is required. If you do not have access then please inform school so that we can arrange alternative provision.

Seesaw is available via the internet or can be used in app form (both android and Apple)

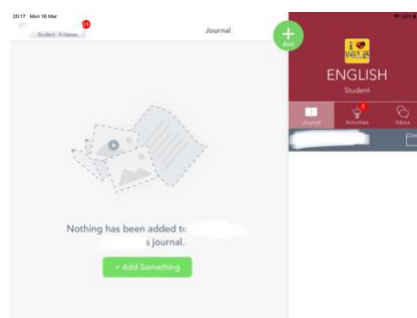


### How to use Seesaw

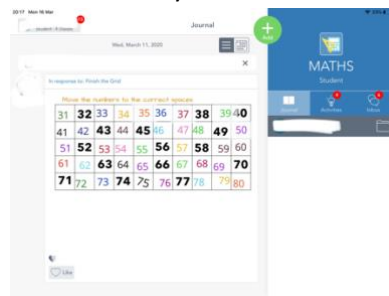
- Every child in school has an account
- Username for the majority are their first name followed by a . then the initial of their surname @ewanrigg.cumbria.sch.uk
- E.g. child's name- Joe Bloggs  
Username- [Joe.b@ewanrigg.cumbria.sch.uk](mailto:Joe.b@ewanrigg.cumbria.sch.uk)  
Password- Ewanrigg1
- Your child will have different classes set up e.g. spelling, Maths, English



- Activities will be set for your child by the teacher who is responsible for them in that lesson
- The children will see red circles with a number in to show when there is something outstanding to complete.



- The teacher can also send announcements which can be found in the inbox for each subject. These should be checked for any instructions.
