Dear Student / Parent / Carer

Firstly, thank you for choosing Netherhall School for your child's secondary school education; we are very much looking forward to your son / daughter joining us in what are very large numbers once again this year, with our September 2023 intake further building on our excellent recruitment to year 7 over recent years.

I am writing to you today to introduce myself as Netherhall School's year 7 transition lead teacher and to let you know that I will be in regular contact with you all over the coming weeks and months to supply you with all of the key information you will need to ensure a smooth transition for your child.

I would like to begin our transition process by informing you of some key dates in our transition programme this year; firstly, our year 7 induction day and induction evening events will be held on Wednesday 5th July, when all new students to Netherhall School will spend the day with us, while on the same evening, students and their parents will be invited to meet their new tutors and enjoy an introductory presentation by our Headteacher, Mr Tromans and myself. A further key set of dates I would like you to be aware of at this early stage in this year's transition are in relation to our plans to hold a summer school for our incoming year 7 students, following the success of this event over the last two years. Our summer school will be held from Monday 14th August to Friday 25th August between 10.00am and 2.30pm each day. Attendance at the summer school will be voluntary and students can attend as many or as few of the sessions as they wish; full details will follow in due course, but I thought you would like to know the dates now, so you are able to plan around these dates should you wish your son or daughter to attend.
